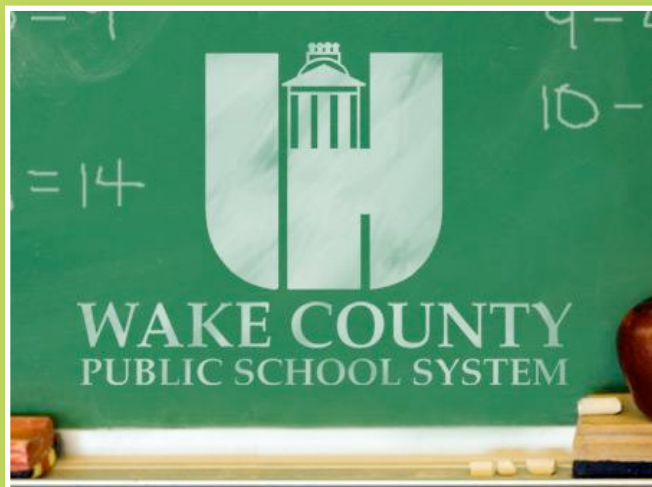


Wake County
