DEBRA GOLDMAN CONSIDERS 2012 RUN

Wake School Board Member nears final decision

CARY, NORTH CAROLINA - Debra Goldman, a current member and former two-term Vice Chair of the Wake County Board of Education has publicly expressed an interest in running for higher office this fall. A final decision will likely come before the February filing period, but Goldman stated that Governor Perdue's recent tax hike proposal solidified her desire to "bring fiscal responsibility to state government."

"I have been contemplating a run for higher office for quite some time," said Goldman. "This recent \$750 million tax hike proposal by the governor just doesn't make sense. Raising taxes isn't the answer. The real solution is fiscal responsibility, something Raleigh has not seen lately."

Goldman, a Republican member of the Wake County School Board, has earned a reputation for being a maverick on key issues relating to the school assignment policy. She has received accolades for courage as a breast cancer survivor and community volunteer. Debra Goldman is also a proud retired volunteer firefighter.
